

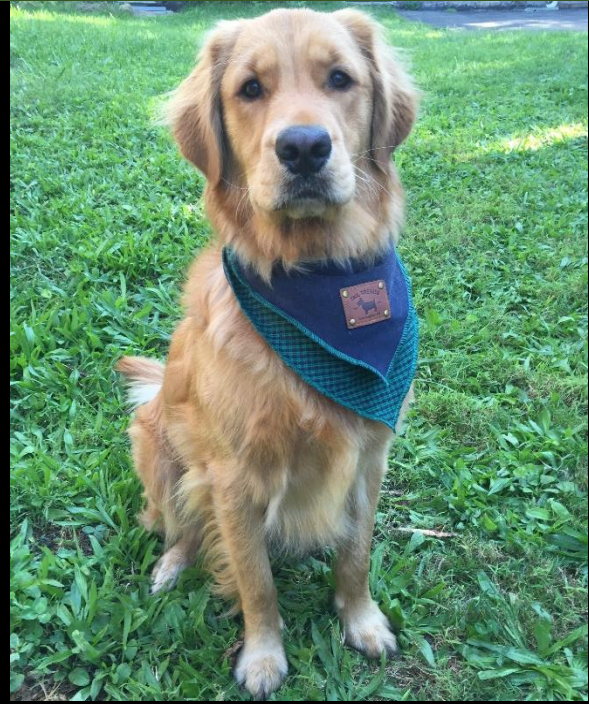

This Program Consists of Four Learning Stations

- Station 1:** Learn how to respect and interact with Schooner!
- Station 2:** Listen to stories and discuss the many types of therapy and assistance dogs and other animals that help people.
- Station 3:** Snuggle and read with Schooner. Books are provided, or bring your own favorite!
- Station 4:** Make a therapy vest and bandana for your take-home stuffed dog!

All four stations are required for all children for this fun, educational program.

- As a group (limited to six children) during Station 1, children will learn how best to interact with Schooner.
- Children will then rotate through the other three stations and will be able to snuggle with Schooner individually.
- Check in begins at 4:15 pm. The program begins promptly at 4:30 pm.

Due to the importance of the group experience during Station 1, no late arrivals will be admitted.
